OPEN VALVE ON POST AND BOTH "T" VALVE SHUTOFFS.

MAKE SURE BYPASS HOSE IS ATTACHED TO ONE OF THE "T" VALVE OUTLETS AND MOVE END OF HOSE OUTSIDE ENCLOSURE TO STREET

CHECK SYSTEM STATUS – IF OFF DUE TO RAIN MOVE RAIN SENSOR SWITCH FROM ACTIVE TO BYPASS/OFF

ADVANCE DIAL TO RUN TIME
ADVANCE TO PROGRAM B USING PROG BUTTON
ADVANCE TO ZONE 6 USING ARROW BUTTON
SET ZONE 6 RUN TIME TO 2:30 OR MORE RUN TIME
RETURN DIAL TO OFF OR RUN POSITION
ATTACH PRESSURE WASH HOSE TO OTHER "T" OUTLET
WHEN READY TO START – TURN DIAL TO MANUAL START, ADVANCE TO ZONE 6
USING ARROW BUTTON, THEN TURN DIAL TO RUN
ADJUST BYPASS "T" VALVE TO KEEP PRESSURE < 90 PSI

WHEN DONE...TURN DIAL TO OFF TO STOP PUMP
CLOSE VALVE ON POST AND CLOSE BOTH "T" SHUTOFFS
PLACE HOSE END OUTSIDE ENCLOSURE BACK IN MIDDLE OF BUSHES
